Landis June of Land situate in Salford Township in the County of Philad^a. Beginning at a white oak a corner of Francis Gandeuvills land thence by land of John Hendrick Snider South west one hundred and six perches to a post in the line of Johanna Freds land thence by that & vacant land North west two hundred and forty perches to a post thence by vacant land North East one hundred & six perches to a post thence by vacant land South East one hundred & thirty four perches & by land of sd Francis Gandeuvitt the same course one hundred & six perches to ye place of Beginning Containing one hundred and fifty acres with usual allowance
