



Surveyed on the tenth day of May 1729 to John Isaac Clym a Tract of Land situate in the township of Gafford in the County of Philada Beginning at a white oak sapling in a line of Henry Rudd's land thence by land of Derick Johnson North East one hundred and five perches to a post thence by the land of Hans Miar and Christian Shover South East two hundred and fourteen perches to a post thence by the lands of John Johnson and Gabreil Shoolar South West one hundred and five perches to a post thence by the said Gabreil Shoolar's North West land and land of Henry Rudd two hundred and fourteen perches to the place of Beginning Containing one hundred thirty two acres with the usual allowance of six p cent.
