

Acres & a Quarter of an Acre & Allowance of six p. ct situate
on a Run emptying into the East side of Plumb Creek about
half a mile above the Kittanning Path including a Tomhawk.
Improvement said to be made by one Kelly in Armstrong Town-
ship Westmorland County. By Warrant of the 7th Day of Feb-
ruary 1776
