



The above is a draught of a Survey made as of the 19th day of October 1860, in pursuance of a Certificate granted to Zadock Wright in the following words, viz. "We the Commissioners appointed to adjust the Claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohogania and Ohio, do hereby Certify that Zadock Wright is entitled to four hundred acres of Land in the County of Yohogania, on Peters creek, to include his settlement made in the year of our Lord 1772, also a right in preemption to four hundred acres adjoining thereto. Given under our hands at Cores Ford the 23^d day of February 1780, in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
