



The above diagram describes a small tract of Land situated in Delaware Township, Pennatta County, Containing six acres and one hundred and forty-five perches, now owned by the Heirs of Isaac Wiley, now surveyed for partitioning the same, it being a part of a larger tract the greater part of which is situated in Perry County, Greenwood Township. Originally surveyed on a warrant to John Leffman, dated the 24th day of May, 1841, containing thirty-two acres and four perches, the balance of which is described by dotted lines.
