

Describe Jackson Township in the County of York, Containing together  
A 3 A. 3 ro. 8 ac. Originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to  
Martin Gerhart, dated 10<sup>th</sup> September, 1750. Lopped from a Survey  
made by Daniel Leese the 27<sup>th</sup> September, A.D. 1840. And at the request  
of Peter Mcconnell, Edward Strasbaugh, Solomon Baker, Jacob and  
George Baubitz & Michael Leib, returned for confirmation October  
18<sup>th</sup>, 1864.
