



Draft of a tract of land situated in West Brunswick Township in the County of  
Schuylkill, containing  $100 \frac{1}{2} \text{ acres}$ , and the allowance of six percent for Roads, Surveyed  
for Abraham Windermuth & Mary Derrall on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1870. It being  
part of a larger tract of land one hundred and eighty-six acres and allowance for  
six percent for Roads &c. Originally surveyed in accordance of a warrant dated  
11<sup>th</sup> June A.D. 1751, in right of John Kneller.
