



Draught of a tract of land situate part in Metal & part in Forest Townships, Franklin County, containing two hundred and twenty-five acres, one hundred and fifty-one perches & allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Resurveyed 29th October, 1829, in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to concentrated Lands under Proprietary rights &c. And by Virtue of an order of Survey dated 30th June, 1767, No. 4090 granted Joseph Kilgore for 200 acres, joining John Lands, Robert Wilson, one Moore and Kitatinny Mountain on Conococheague Creek opposite a large Deer Lick in Path Valley.
