



Situate in Frankforton Township Blair County, first surveyed  
the 4<sup>th</sup> Oct. 1849, on a warrant granted to Joseph Kemp dated the 23<sup>rd</sup>  
January, 1847, it then contained 67 1/2 acres but interferes  
with an older survey in name of William Steele and resurveyed the 2<sup>nd</sup>  
day of October 1850, in pursuance of an order of resurvey dated  
the 5<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1850 and the said interference excluded and  
other vacant land taken up to fill the warrant
