


Surveyed the above described tract of land the tenth day of November A. D. 1806. for William Herrod s. b. l. virtue of his warrant for 300 acres dated September 8th 1838. Containing three hundred & five acres & seventy perches & allowance of six per cent & so. Situate on the west side of Pine creek about one mile above the mouth of slate Creek, in Brown Township Lycoming County & bounded as above. Note. the improvements are about sixteen acres cleared land & a Cabin on it began in I know not when. Note. also the dotted l. o. b. l. represent o. b. l. with a survey and warrant to Nathaniel Simcox & returned for Edward Diggin. It is supposed also to interfere with a survey on Warrant to James Wilson. No. 1526.
