Thence by land of Crawford &c. NE 88 W 81 perches to beginning. Contg. 48.150 per. and all

Draft of a tract of land containing 48 acres and 150 perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Situated in Harmony township in the County of Forest formerly to Heggeny Co. of Venango Surveyed the 7<sup>th</sup> day of February A.D. 1865 by Daniel Robb. Henderpeter Surveyor of Venango Co. Pa. (which portion where tract lies now in Forest since Oct. 1866) under Wm. H. Landis, in consequence of a warrant granted to George Haslet dated the 31<sup>st</sup> day of January A.D. 1865.
