



A draught of a lot of Ground, adjoining the Center Square on the South side of High Street in the Town of Carlisle in the County of Cumberland, containing in Breadth sixty feet and in length two hundred feet, and marked in a General Plan of said Town No. 142, bounded northward with High Street aforesaid, Eastward with the Center Square, Southward with Lot No. 141, and Westward with Lot No. 124. Return'd into the Secretary's Office the 17th day of April 1772, by Warrant dated the 16th instant to Robert Miller.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this second day of October 1905.
