

A Draft of a tract of land situate on the East branch of Tunkhannock Creek in the Township of Lenox Susquehanna County, adjoining land granted to Elizabeth Harris on the southeast, Vacant land on the southwest, Mrs. Gray on the Northwest, & land of the said John Dowd on the northeast, Containing eighty-five acres and one hundred and twenty-six perches beside the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c. With an improvement since 1806. Surveyed September 18<sup>th</sup> 1838, for John Dowd in pursuance of a warrant dated August 15<sup>th</sup> 1838.
