


Claim of Elliott's heirs



The above Draught describes a tract of Land in Rye township —
Survey'd the 15 Apr 1823. In pursuance of a warrant dated the
18th December 1822 for 5.5 acres granted to Robert Kelly
Containing sixty acres ninety two perches and allowance; and
clear of dispute 50 acres 27 perches and allowance —
