Originally surveyed for James Kerr the 20th day of August 1794 on Warrant dated the 21st day of February 1794.

Resurveyed for Abraham Kerns the 26th day of October 1832 in pursuance of an order granted by the Board of Property dated the 20th day of February 1832 pr. John Bennet D.S. Resurveyed and examined the 13th day of July 1833
