



Situate on Wolfs Camp run, in Londonderry township Bedford County Containing 82 acres 158 perches and allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Surveyed by Michael Reed Esq. the 23rd of October 1850. Being part of a tract that originally contained 178^{ac} allowance Surveyed the 19th of May 1819. on Warrant dated 4th of Febr. y 1819 granted to Ludwick Lyberger for 170 ac.

The above 82^{ac} 158^{ps} returned for patenting the 21st of Feby 1854
