



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Bearing date the 16<sup>th</sup> Day of April Anno Dom. 1735. Surveyed To Peter Leman a tract of Land in the Township of Hempfield & County of Lancaster. Beginning at a Maple a Corner of Reinera Young's Land thence East South East 168 per. to a Spanish Oak, thence North 135 per. to a post. thence North West by West 152 per. to a Black Oak, thence South 83 deg. West 129 per. to a Black Oak thence South by East 57 per. to a Hicory, thence South 56 deg. East 106 per. to a white Oak. thence South 24 perches to the place of Beginning. Containing One Hundred & Eighty Eight Acres with the usual of Allowance of Six  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cent.

Surveyed the Sixteenth Day of May 1735.
