The land North east of the dotted line marked near the middle of the above draft & containing 93° 41P5 is claimed by Matthias Hollenback, on a running Warrant which has never returned, nor the Warrantees name is not inserted upon ~~Hollenback's~~ Hollenback's draft, therefore it cannot be ascertained what Warrant he intends to apply to the above piece of land. Hollenback's lines was run and marked upon the ground A.D. 1793. M^r Hollenback showed me all his title to the above Warrant land; his leading is in the name of Hannah Stone dated 28th Aug^t 1792, and the pond mentioned in sd Warrant is nearly two miles from the above described land. And another Warrant in the name of Nathan Waller, Jun^r of the same date, is near four miles from the above described land.
