



A Draught of twenty six acres and one hundred and ten perches of land with six per cent for Roads, situate in Derry Township in Mifflin County, surveyed 11<sup>th</sup> September 1812 in pursuance of a Warrant to Henry Long dated 29<sup>th</sup> August 1812.

Note. Improvement on this land at time of Survey a large Cabbin house and a family living in it, ~~at time of Survey~~ and an acre of land cleared, under fence, and in a state of Cultivation.
