



Situate in Shirley Township Huntingdon County No 1 Containing one hundred acres and one hundred and thirty seven perches and allowance Surveyed March 22<sup>nd</sup> 1810 on Warrant granted to Hugh Logan dated March 21<sup>st</sup> 1787. No 2. Containing two hundred and thirty one acres and one hundred and thirty two perches and allowance. Surveyed September 30<sup>th</sup> 1811 on a Warrant granted Simon Logan dated June 19<sup>th</sup> 1811.

Note, There is about ten acres cleared on the above tract, a good Cabbin and a family residing therein
