



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 14 January 1786 Surveyed the
15th April 1791 to Adam Miller the above described tract of land
situate in Weisenberg Township Northampton County contain-
ing fourteen Acres one hundred and forty perches and the
allowance of Six p. Cent &c^a

The piece marked A. has been Returned for Peter Rau part
of 11³/₄ Acres in pursuance of his warrant dated the 21st August
1790 & contains 2 Acres & 140 perches & allowance.

The other part containing 12 Acres was Returned the 2^d May 1792
for Miller. They have since been at Law in the Common Pleas at Easton by
a Judgement of the Court dated the 10th August 1796 the piece marked
A. was Adjudged to be the Property of Miller - see a Copy of the Judgement.
