Surveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> April 1791 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to William Mansel dated Feb<sup>r</sup>. 22<sup>d</sup> 1791 Called "the Valley of Jehosaphet" Containing 202 acres 896 perches with 6 p cent allowance for Roads &c.
