Being part of a larger Tract of Land which was Originally Surveyed by William Kersey late D.S. on the 4th mo. 2d 1794. In pursuance of a Warrant for 200 as Granted to John Rippey bearing date the 29th day of August Anno Domini 1789. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 12th day of May 1806 for James Greer the present owner who desired me to make Return of the Draught.
