



Situate in Chancetford Township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 11^{ac} & 143 Perches & allowance, Being part of a Larger Tract of Land which was originally surveyed by William Kersey late D.S. on the 4th mo. 2^d 1794 In pursuance of a Warrant for 100^{ac} Granted to David Morgan bearing date the 25th day of February A.D. 1743/4. Divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 12th day of May 1806 and now at the request of the present owner John Keener, I am desired to make Return of the Draught as Calculated, examined and Corrected the 19th day of August A.D. 1809.
