Containing one hundred and thirty one acres and twelve perches of Land with allowance of six percentum for Roads. Surveyed the 28th day of December 1809 for Willam Means in pursuance of a warrant dated the 14th day of November 1809, And Certified by Jonathan Stevens D.S.
