

We the Commissioners for adjusting the Claims to unpatented Lands in the Countries of Monongalia Yohogania and Ohio do hereby Certify that John McLoney is intitled to four Hundred acres of Land in Yohogania County situate on the waters of Shertir to include his Settlement made in the year of our Lord Seventeen hundred & Seventy two also a right in Preemption to one thousand Acres Adjoining thereto.

Given under our hands at Coxes Fort this 22nd day of January 1780 & in the fourth Year of the Commonwealth
