



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Fawn Tow<sup>n</sup> on the West Side of Susquehannah River formerly Lancaster but now York County, on the North Side of Slate Ridge & near the Temporary Line Survey'd for James Graham in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Alexander McConliss for 200<sup>a</sup> bearing Date the 4<sup>th</sup> of May 1744. the Said Graham having Purchased one half of the Right of Said Warrant. & after the Survey, <sup>he</sup> Paid £6. to the Receiver Generals Office on Account of the Land that the Survey contain'd above the 100<sup>a</sup>. Certify'd on Behalf of John Churchman Deputy Surveyor (to whom in the Said Warrant was directed)

5 mo 22<sup>nd</sup> 1767.
