



Situate in Alegany Township, in the County of Huntingdon, on the South East Side of the West Branch of Susquehannah - about one Mile from Said Branch.

Containing 400 Four Hundred acres & Sixty five perches, and the usual allowance of Six per Cent for Roads. Surveyed the 9th day of October 1802.

In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 10th of March 1785, and of an order of the Board of property dated the 2^d day of March 1802.
