



The above is a Draught of a Survey made April the 5th day 1794, in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Joseph McGaffin for 400 Ac^s of Land Dated the 14th of April 1792. Situate North and West of the River Ohio, on the West Bank of Big Beaver Creek. Adjoining Land Granted to Barnabas McShane, Called (o-7-2-) Raccoons Dwelling. Containing four Hundred and forty Acres With Allowance of Six p^r. cent for Roads.
