

The above described tract of land is situate on the Chesnut Ridge in Donegal township Westmoreland County which was surveyed in pursuance of two several warrants granted to William McClain the part containing 1020 89 pr. & allowance was surveyed by John Gay D.5. on a warrant dated 28th March 1838 the 3d of March 1838 and the part containing 770 15 pr. was surveyed by George Mechling D.5. the 14th Nov. 1850 on warrant dated the 4th Nov. 1850 containing in (obl.) hole one hundred seventy nine acres and one hundred and four perches and the usual allowance &c.
