

Surveyed April 15<sup>th</sup> 1785 unto Casper Mercklen the above discribed tract of land. Situate on Sewickley Creek in Huntington Township Westmoreland County. Containing three hundred fifty nine acres  $\frac{1}{4}$  and allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c.
