


Vacant Land



A Draught of a Tract of Land Surveyed the 17th day of November 1793 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Charles Morgan for 400 Acres dated the 29th day of March 1793. Situate North & West of the River Ohio in Jonathan Sreet's District on Brush Creek by Estimation two or three miles from the mouth where it empties into Conaquinnessing to include Woods Improvement Called Hill Seat Containing four Hundred & thirty eight Acres three quarters together with the usual Allowance of 6 p.c.
