

Situate on Paystille Piney Riage opposite to John Davisons improvement & about a mile from Gerrards Mills in the township & County of Huntingdon containing 277° and the usual allowance for roads surveyed the twenty third day of November 1791 in pursuance of a warrant dated the fifth day of March 1787.
