

The above described tract of land situate in Hamilton Township Franklin County containing two acres and eight perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c was surveyed and laid off for Frederick Roemer by William S Davis then Deputy Surveyor it being part of a larger tract of 251 $\frac{95}{100}$ 76 $\frac{1}{4}$ per & allowance which was surveyed the 12th day of June 1767 in pursuance of a warrant granted to David Black dated the 4th day of October 1738
