



The above described tract of land containing twenty four acres fifty perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c surveyed the 4th day of September 1822 for Frederick Roemer by William S Davis then Deputy Surveyor is part of a larger tract of 34.3^{acres} 63^{perches} surveyed the 12th day of June 1767 in pursuance of a warrant granted Saml. Morehead dated 3^d day of July 1762 (formerly Cumberland now) Franklin County examined the above described survey & find it to be correct Certified this 28th day of November 1825
