



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor Dated the 5th of ye 2^d mo. Anno. Dom. 1737, the above described Tract of Land was surveyed unto Joshua Nicholas in Robinson Township in the County of Lancaster. Begining at a post at a corner of the Land of Henry Holston. Thence South 20 Degrees East by Vacant Land 74 perches to a post thence South 86 Degrees East by the Land of Thomas Morgan 7 perches to a post, thence South 15 Degrees West by ye said Land 92 perches to a post, thence South 54 Degrees East by the same Land 68 perches to a small black oak, thence South 18 Degrees East by the said Morgan's Land 25 perches to a hickory, thence North 80 Degrees East by Vacant Land 170 perches to a black oak, thence North 10 Degrees West by Vacant Land 221 perches to a post, thence South 80 Degrees West by the land of Henry Holston 201 perches to ye place of Beginning. Containing two hundred & sixty two acres beside the allowance of six p. cent for Roads.
