Begining at a white oak thence South Go Degrees West by vacant Land 180 perches to a hickery, thence North 30 Degrees West by vacant cant Land 236 perches to a small Black oak, Thence North Go Degrees East by vacant Land 180 perches to a Spanish oak. Thence South 30 Degrees East by vacant Land 180 perches to a Spanish oak. Thence South 30 Degrees East by vacant Land and the Land of John Jones 236 pehes to ye place of Begining. Containing two hundred and fifty acres beside ye allowance of Six p Cent for Roads.
