

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the thirtieth day of October 1734. Surveyed unto Christopher Nyeman a tract of Land Situate in New Cowissinoppin in ye County of Philada Begining at a hickery thence by Vacant Land South East one hundred and twenty perches to a post thence by Vacant Land South West one hundred and seventy eight perches to a post, thence by Vacant Land North west one hundred and twenty perches to a post thence by Vacant Land North East one hundred & seventy eight perches to the place of Begining, Containing one hundred & twenty five acres with the usual allowance of Six p. Cent.
