



Land surveyed to S. Freeman

Surveyed 9th & 10th June A.D. 1840, the above described tract of land in pursuance of a warrant to Jno. Moorhead and Hugh Devling for 200 acres of unimproved Land dated March 13th 1839. Situate in Shippen Township, County of McKean and between the West and main Branch of the Sinnamahoning.—

Beginning at a post thence South forty perches & five tenths to a Hemlock, thence West three hundred & twenty perches. to a post, thence North one hundred & seventy one perches & five tenths to a White pine, thence South sixty seven & 3/4 degrees, East three hundred & forty six perches to place of Beginning. Containing two hundred acres and allowance.
