



The above is a Draught of a Survey made Novr 20th, 1833, for the heirs of William McCaslin, Dec'd containing ninety nine Acres & 35 perches, Strict measure, situate in Hanover Township, Washington County, on the waters of Kings Creek, being part of an Original Survey called Contention, executed March 17th 1786, in pursuance of a Certificate for 400 Acres granted to George McCaslin, lines Dec'd and duly Entered &c. The Dotted l represent the balance of the tract which has lately been surveyed & returned for Robert K. McCaslin and Alex' McCaslin, heirs of George McCaslin aforesaid.
