In Pursuance of an Act of Assembly Passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of Certain Lands therein Mentioned and by Virtue of a Commission under the hand and seal of Office from John Lukins, Esq. Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania, bearing date at Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1783, the Above tract of Land Containing two hundred and Nineteen Acres and fifty three Perches and allowance of 6 \$\frac{1}{2}\$! Cent for Roads &c. Was Surveyed on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of July 1785, by
