



In pursuance of a warrant dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of August 1766 granting to be surveyed unto John Reed the quantity of 3.350<sup>9</sup> of land (in r.t. of the original purchase of 5000<sup>9</sup> made of the late Hon. Proprietary W<sup>m</sup> Penn by Francis Smith) there was surveyed the 13<sup>th</sup> day of October 1767 unto John Roberts Miller assignor of the said John Reed the above described tract of land situate in Lower Merion township Philadelphia County containing fourteen acres & allowance of 6 Pct.
