


FORM NO. I.



Situated in Manallen Township Adams County and
Surveyed the 13th day of August 1793 in pursuance of
a Warrant for 200^a granted to Andrew Noel dated
the 4th of May 1793. By Moses Clean U.S.
26th March 1793

a copy of the above Draught I examined & sent to
your Office about the first of November 1805 in
which the Township is called Franklin instead of
Manallen the Township is called Franklin in the
Survey book as recorded by Mr. Clean but the land
does not lay within 5 miles of Franklin Township
Conoccocheague Creek runs through it no part of such
branch rises in Franklin Township Certified the 5th
December 1805
