

The above is the draught of a Survey made April 5<sup>th</sup> 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Joseph Nouisse Esq<sup>E</sup> on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1792 Situate Northwest of the Ohio river on the Waters of Beaver Creek - adjoining land granted to Caleb North --- called Charleville -- containing 425 Acres & 16 perches with the usual allowance of 6 p Cent &c.
