



The above is a draught of a survey made the 31st of January 1795 in pursuance of a warrant granted to William Nichols for 400 acres of land dated the 4th of Janu. 1794 situate north and west of the river Ohio on the waters of Slippery Creek adjoining land granted to John Nichols called Big Walnut containing four hundred acres and allowance of six Per cent for roads.
