In pursuance of an application Granted to William Meek dated the 1st day of April 1767. No 3286.

Resurvey'd the above tract the 4th day of October 1803 agreeable to its boundaries, and appears to Contain Two hundred and fifty six Acres and 82 perches and the Allowance of Six pr. Cent for roads &c.
