

Situate near Spruce-(Originally called the North Branch of Junata-) in Franklin Township Huntingdon County Containing Three Hundred and Forty one Acres one hundred & titty four perches and the usual Allowance. First Surveyed the 4th day of Dec. 1793. and resurveyed agreeably to the original lines found on the ground the 8th day of May 1838. In pursuance of a Warrant granted to William Malheney dated Oct. 25th 1784.
