



By Virtue of a Warrant date the 6th September 1813 Surveyed the 20th June 1821 to Jacob Postens the above described tract of land formerly situate in Lower Smithfield (now in) Stroud and Lower Smithfield township Northampton County containing three hundred and thirty-six acres seventy six perches and allowance of six P cent &c^o. The above tract was formerly surveyed by James Scull late D. Surveyor for Charles Dealy. Jacob Postens made a valuable improvement on it in the year 1798, has now two houses on it and about 30 acres thereof cleared on which grain of all sorts has been raised & has had it in Possession ever since.
