



By virtue of a Warrant dated the 5th July 1751 Surveyed the 6. August
1751 to Benjamin Parvin the above described tract of land. Situate on Tomague-a
branch of Schuylkill-(formerly in Bucks County) now in West Penn Township Northampton
County. Containing one hundred and fifty four acres a quarter and the allowance
of 6 P Cent taken from the field works of James Scull late Deputy Surveyor the 14th
Aug 1809.
