Surveyed on a Warrant granted to Nicholas Peery for 50<sup>acres</sup> dated the 14<sup>th</sup> day of March 1755 by George Stevenson then D.S. and returned by Daniel Small under Contract 15<sup>th</sup> Jan<sup>y</sup> 1829. Divided 6<sup>th</sup> August 1830
